Fall Concert

The Fall Concert has been moved from October 28 to Thursday, October 30.

All District Orchestra Auditions

Money for All-District orchestra \$7.00 needs to be turned in. If you have pre-ordered t-shirts for All-District orchestra please bring that separately. It is \$10.00. For those who auditioned and were accepted to the All District orchestra, the clinic is on Saturday November 1st at Tulsa Union. If you have not received a note by email or your student has not shown a note about all district orchestra you can email us at school and we will send the information to you.

The All City Festival of Orchestras Concert for grades 6-12 is at the Bartlesville High School Fine Arts Center on **December 4 at 7:00 pm**. All String students will be involved in that concert.

Students who are involved in All State Auditions will leave the next day, December 5, after school to go to Moore for the Auditions.

All OMEA Auditions at Westmoore HS are also fast approaching. Students will leave after school on Friday December 5th. The auditions are December 6th. All state orchestra excerpts are now available and students need to be putting a lot of time in now on their etudes and scales.

Uniform Guidelines

The uniforms are nearly all passed out. There are some guidelines that need to be followed with the care and wear of the uniform. Girls' dresses must be hemmed, not cut off if they need to be shorter. Do not cut off the dresses. If you need a dress hemmed and do not know how to sew, call Expert Alterations at 333-0220, Sew-N-Go at 336-7397, Alterations Plus at 336-7587. The dresses need to be hand washed and drip dried, not dry-cleaned. Boys' shirts need to be washed after every wearing. The Tuxedos pants must be hemmed to fit. Please don't shorten them by cutting them off. All tuxes must be dry-cleaned.

Concert attire for Girls: Orchestra dresses, black dress shoes, dark hose, modest jewelry. No flip-flops, tennis shoes or boots are to be worn with any orchestra uniform. Concert attire for boys: tuxedos, bow ties, black dress shoes and socks. No flip-flops, tennis shoes, or boots are to be worn with the tuxedos. Thank you,

Band Uniform Care

When your uniform becomes soiled, please follow these instructions.

- Remove the gauntlets & blue insert from the uniform.
- 2. Take the uniform only (not the gauntlets and insert) to Archers Cleaners.
- 3. Instruct them to **WASH** the uniform per instruction that they have already been given.
- 4. Hand wash gauntlets and insert if needed. Use mild soap and a brush to clean. Rinse in warm water and allow to air dry. DO NOT PUT IN THE DRYER. Do not delay in cleaning the gauntlets as they will become harder to clean.
